General Membership Meeting

October 17, 2011

1. Meeting was called to order by Courtney West, PMAB president at 7:05 PM
2. Minutes of September 19, 2011 meeting were reviewed and approved
3. Financial report (copy attached) presented by Keith Hirschman, treasurer
4. Athletic Director Updates

Athletic Director, Jason Bellamy reported that state tournament for fall sports will begin in approximately 2 weeks. PMHS athletics now compete as a 2A school.

Try-outs for winter sports begin on November 15th.

Proceeds from the girls vs. Bel Air volleyball games will go to Breast Cancer Awareness.

5. Community Updates

A. Community Relations: George Hall & Sam Marge have volunteered to head community relations.

B. Merchandising: no report

C. Concessions: Keith has secured wall lockers that can be used for storage in the indoor concession space. Coach Troyer's father has volunteered to install the lockers.

Courtney has found a gentleman who is willing to donate an upright freezer for the stadium concession stand. Brian has volunteered to pick up the freezer. The small freezer now located in the stadium concession stand will be moved to the indoor stand.

The indoor concession stand will require running water in order to sell hot foods.

The boosters are in need of 1 or more microwaves for the concessions stands and are asking if anyone has a micro-wave they wish to for donations. Two donors came forward.

Courtney has ordered two pizza warmer bags from Vocellis. This will eliminate the need to return the bags to Vocellis after each event.

Profits from the November 10, 2011 Powder-Puff Football Game will be split with the National Honor Society.

Chick-fil A currently charges \$3.00 per sandwich and per our agreement the maximum we can charge is \$3.50. Chick-fil A will check to see if the \$3.00 charge can be reduced. Their sponsorship is \$4,000 over 2 years.

A gas grill has been donated to the booster club. Hamburgers will be served the November 4th varsity football game.

D. Membership: Tom Jacobs reported that as of 9-19-2011, 89 parents/coaches have joined the PMAB. A total of \$3,885 has been raised through membership. Varsity field hockey leads the way with 15 out of 17 participants (88%) being members. Decals, umbrellas & blankets are on back order. Classic Sports is currently offering a special on umbrellas.

6. Bull Roast

A. Ticket Sales: As of this meeting, 120 bull roast tickets have been distributed.

B. Silent Auction/Door Prizes: 8 team baskets have been committed towards the bull roast. A list of the businesses (46) contacted for donations was presented.

7. New Business

- A. Amendment of By-Laws: The following amendments to the PMAB By-Laws were presented:
- a. To change the monthly membership meeting from the third Monday of each month to the fourth Monday of each month.
 - b. To allow the Board of Directors without a vote of the general membership to approve an expenditure of up to \$750.00.
 - c. That voting privileges shall be afforded to any active member and in the event of a deadlock, the president shall cast the deciding vote.

These items will be voted on by the membership at the November 21, 2011 meeting:

- B. Baseball Request – Scoreboard. The request by Coach Roseland that the PMAB enter into an agreement with the Emmorton Recreation Council (ERC) for a loan of approximately \$13,000 for the purchase and installation of a baseball scoreboard was presented. This will be a non-recourse loan and will be paid back to the PMAB, who in turn will pay ERC. A formal agreement similar to the one between the ERC and the PMAB for the stadium scoreboard will be drafted. ERC will have use of the scoreboard for its games. The baseball team has approximately \$12,760 in place and anticipates raising additional funds from its 2012 and 2013 mulch sales. The measure was approved by the membership

The PMAB will draft guidelines for future loan requests

- C. Girls Basketball Uniforms A measure was presented to approve the purchase of home and away Under Armor uniforms for the girls varsity basketball team. The cost is \$1,950 and the uniforms will be ordered by the athletic director from Yorktowne Sports. The measure was approved.
- D. PTSA Basket Bingo - As in past years the PMAB will donate a basket to this event.
