

# **PMHS ATHLETIC BOOSTERS GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES: 16 October 2017**

**CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to Order at 7:05 by Todd Williams.

We have some strong sponsorship proceeds and some new sponsors.
