5. Committee Reports
 - 5.1. Community Relations - 3 large sponsors will be paying in the next 3 months - approximately \$7500.00
 - 5.2. Merchandise - no report
 - 5.3. Concessions - Powderpuff is Friday - Honors Society to staff - profits split with that group. \$5000.00 profit for the Fall Season - cheer event made \$1100.00. Big winter events upcoming
 - 5.4. Membership 115
 - 5.5. Fundraising - Bull roast planning meeting early December. Rob reported that a band has offered to play the Bullroast at a nominal cost.
Jog-a-thon need to work on prizes - The idea is that each teams highest fundraiser will win a prize. Tentative date is a Saturday after the Spring teams have been finalized (First weekend in April? last weekend in March?) - Tentative date approved March 26
 - 5.6. Scholarship - Board approved a reduction of GPA to 2.0. It was discussed as to whether or not to apply points for countywide athletic awards - All County, All Conference, Harford County Sportsmanship award, etc. Some concern was voiced as to whether this may affect spring only athletes with these selections made after scholarship decision.
6. Harford County Booster Roundtable - Rob met with other booster club Presidents from around the county to discuss ideas related to membership, fundraising, etc. Rob passed around a pamphlet from North Harford and had some suggestions

from C. Milton Wright. CMW gives an incentive to coaches of \$10 per member from their team. CMW also has a raffle at halftime of varsity basketball for a chance to shoot a half court shot, if the shot is made the prize is \$100.00. This idea was discussed and will be looked into as a fundraiser for the PMHS boosters.
