1. Meeting called to order 7:04 PM
2. Minutes for the December 2010 General Membership meeting approved.
3. Financial Report (see attached) - \$6643.83 unrestricted funds. The final payment for the Emmorton Rec. loan has been made.

It was suggested that we have an event for each season and that there be a greater incentive to the teams to participate, possibly 40% to 50% of the money they raise. The question was made as to whether or not this could be a mandatory event for athletes. Jason said that it would be impossible to make it mandatory, but that he felt the money split was a very good incentive. Each sport maintains an account and that money stays with those teams (varsity & junior varsity). Coach Roseland suggested that since Field Hockey has already done a

jog-a-thon, they should keep 100% of the money raised. *A motion was made to table the Spring 2011 jog-a-thon and go with a per season event starting in Fall 2011 – Motion passed*
