COMMITTEE UPDATES:

Community Relations:

- Should be receiving a check shortly in the amount of \$3,000 from Freedom Financial, one of our largest sponsors.
- An application was submitted to Wegman's for the bingo but rejected because we already received a donation this calendar year. Advised to resubmit the application after January 1st so it can be approved in the new calendar year.
- Bill has met with Dick's about sponsorship. Considering an in-store day for each season. Bill will follow up with Dick's District Office

Merchandising:

- T-Shirts are being sold at Basketball games. Boys slogan reads "I Believe We Will Win". Girls slogan reads "6th Man"

Concessions:

- Cheerleading Competition sold 120 Chick-Fil-A sandwiches and 16 pizza's in an hour and a half

FUNDRAISING:

- Board met and prepared list of priorities for upcoming year.
- Approved Uniforms purchase as per the schedule.
- Approved continuing to assist with Trainer's support
- Agreed that it is important that Boosters make another large donation back to Patterson Mill. Will prepare a list of recommendations and bring them back to the membership for review.

Pay To Play:

- School Board voted 604 to remove from next year's budget

- Alysson Krchnavy was a strong advocate for removing this from the budget. Recommend that individuals send a letter to Ms. Krchnavy thanking her for her support on this issue

- Check should arrive in January
- Boosters have expressed desire in staffing the Playoff game (if it becomes available)
