**GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING**

**February 19, 2013**

1. The meeting was called to order by Bill Benson, PMAB President at 7:04 PM
2. Minutes of December 17, 2012 meeting were reviewed and approved. Please note the January 2013 general membership meeting was cancelled.
3. The financial report was presented Mary Price, Treasurer. The ending balance is \$29,859 Un-encumbered funds total \$18,307. A cash projection sheet was made available to those members in attendance.
4. Athletic Director Updates Jason Bellamy
  - a. Girls basketball was seeded #1 for their region and will play their first game at home against Elkton. Boys basketball was seeded #7 and will play at Edgewood.
  - b. The swim team finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in Harford County and 4<sup>th</sup> in the region A total of 23 swimmers will compete in the state tournament at UMCP.

5. Committee Updates
  - a. Community Relations- Freedom Financial will be a sponsor for the next 3 years @ \$3,000 per year. Seasons Pizza has agreed to an exclusive sponsorship contract for \$2,500 per year. Bill Benson recognized Greg Golezewski who through his volunteer efforts has secured \$3,000 in donations from his company T. Rowe Price.
  - b. Merchandising – Approximately \$300 is sales form the fashion show
  - c. Concessions – Cheer & JV wrestling rodeo were the largest concession events for the fall season
  - d. Membership – Membership stands at 127 members as of tonight’s meeting. In the future all members will be notified via e-mail as to the dates of the general membership meetings.
