General Membership Meeting

September 11, 2012

1. The meeting was called to order by Bill Benson, PMAB President at 7:05 PM.
2. Minutes of the August 20, 2012 meeting were reviewed and approved.
3. A financial report was presented by Mary Price, Treasurer. The cash balance on hand is \$18,034. A detailed cash projection sheet was made available to members in attendance.
4. Athletic Director Updates Jason Bellamy
 - Tickets for the PM/Bel Air football game will be presale only
 - Adult 10 game home passes are now \$25.00
 - Student passes for the 2012/13 season are \$20.00
5. Committee Updates
 - a. Community relations- George & Sam are in the process of contacting past sponsors. Chick Fil A will not be a sponsor this year. Freedom Financial sponsorship is for 3 years at \$3,000 per year. Harford Community College sponsorship for this year is \$1,000 down for \$2,500 last year. The committee is awaiting an answer from Vocelli's Pizza as to their sponsorship for this athletic season. PNC wants to forgo a specific dollar amount for sponsorship and instead offer a certain amount for each new account opened.
 - b. Merchandising – A table will be set up for sales at the PM/Bel Air football game and again during American Education week. It was discussed that for high priced merchandise, only pre-paid orders would be accepted.
 - c. Concessions Greg Golczewski reported sales have been steady for games so far and he is gearing up for the PM/ Bel Air and homecoming football games.
 - d. Memberships are ahead of last year's pace. To date there are 58 paid members not counting the memberships Karen received at tonight's meeting. Individual team numbers will be available at the October meeting.
 - e. Scholarships – all scholarships funds have been dispersed to the appropriate parties.
 - f. Team Liaisons – no report
 - g. Bull Roast Tickets are currently on sale. There will be a bull roast planning meeting @ 6:45 at the Panera near Wegmans on September 13, 2012.

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- h. Bingo – Spring bingo will be held on March 15, 2013. Parking issues need to be worked out due to the Middle School paly being scheduled for the same date.
- i. Program Book/Webmaster The committee is open to ideas for the web-site i.e. updates of alumni participation in college sports etc.

6 Discussions

- a. Summary of Executive Board Meeting – The PMAB banner is in need of replacement. By-laws should be reviewed every 2-3 years. Any changes should be addressed to the president. Folders for the winter sport teams will be similar to those given out for fall sports. Let Jason know if you want to add any additional information included in the folders. It was decided a committee be formed to discuss uniform replacement procedures for 2013.
- b. Field House Update - Still in the preliminary stages. An engineer will look at the proposed site and existing field houses and offer recommendations. The PMAB executive board will meet with the Emmorton Rec Council in October to discuss a possible partnership.
- c. Homecoming – The athletic department will be coordinating this year’s homecoming (Oct 5th). Activities will include an after school pep rally, a carnival theme event with food, drinks and games on the front parking lot from 2:25 to 6:30±. Volunteers will be needed to serve food and drinks. Spirit Wear, PMAB memberships, and bull roast tickets will be available. The athletic department is looking for 8 convertible cars for homecoming. Due to liability issues the Jones Automobile Group cannot supply the cars. There will be a “Rock and Bowl” event after the homecoming dance at the Forest Hill Bowling Lanes from 10:30 PM til 1:30 AM. The football coaches will chaperone this event.
- d. Indoor Concession Stand- Lowes has offered an 18 cu. ft. refrigerator at half price (\$150.00). The plumbing issues are still to be resolved. The membership was asked if anyone knew of a plumber that was willing to help out.
- e. Year End/Current Year Tax Issues – The tax exempt certificate has been received. The certificate is good through 2017.
- f. Expenditure Policy – Tabled until next meeting
 - 1. Purchase of decals. The membership committee of the PMAB requested \$300 to purchase sports decals to be used as incentives for membership and for sale. A motion was made, seconded, and unanimously approved.

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- g. Logo/mascot design A motion was made to pursue the possibility of designing a singular husky mascot logo that could be used by all of the school's organizations. Jason mentioned a professional firm that designs mascots for high school, colleges and professional teams. He estimated the cost to be \$1,500 to \$2,000. Their website is www.sfdesignimpact.com.
- h. Expenditures for approval
 - 1. Accounting - A motion for an addition \$200.00 for accounting purposes was presented, seconded and unanimously approved.
 - 2. Homecoming \$150 gift card donation – A motion was presented requesting the PMAB donate \$150.00 for gift cards to be distributed as prizes at the chemical free event after the homecoming dance. The motion was a second and unanimously passed
 - 3. Husky wear – A motion to allow \$2,700 to replenish the spirit wear inventory. The motion was seconded and unanimously approved.
